- Ensure that every student has a communication system and staff are trained accordingly
- Build student social, physical and emotional wellbeing

Our initiatives include

- Nambour Special School Pedagogy Wheel
- Create and distribute communication calendar to wider school community
- Create 2 x ICT labs (Primary and Secondary)
- Purchase APPS for curriculum IPADS to support student engagement
- Strong focus on staff training and development – Professional Learning week, Observation and Feedback, Collaborative Learning Communities, 'How to sessions'
- Development of strong support networks – In class curriculum support, Communication Coach and Positive Behaviour for Learning coach
- Develop suitable outdoor spaces to promote student socialisation, wellbeing and physical development

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Purchase ICT resources – 3 x touchscreens / 16 x desktops - \$20,000
- Research and training of 2 staff members in Roadmap of Communication Competence - \$5,000
- Purchase 20 PODD (Pragmatic Organisation Dynamic Display) devices - \$10,000
- Creation and distribution of Communication calendar 2019 - \$2,000
- Review and edit of Nambour Special School Pedagogy Wheel - \$1,500
- 10 x IPAD purchases for Curriculum engagement - \$6,000
- IPAD APP purchases - \$5,000
- Develop playground and outdoor teaching area – \$30,500
