This funding will be used to

- Maintain effective transitions at key junctures – GR8 Start Program / Transition 2 School Plan / Transition from school plan
- Provide students and staff with ICT equipment to support student engagement, communication and academic progress
- Further develop physical resources to support student engagement – Sensory spaces/ Makerspace
- Build staff capacity - disability specific pedagogies / Australian Curriculum / Case management
- Build leadership capability of teacher and teacher aide workforce

Our initiatives include

- Developing school/community partnership with Bushkids – Playgroup established
- Developing lead teachers in disability specific pedagogies
- Creating 2 Engine Rooms and a Makerspace resource on Primary and Secondary campus
- Purchasing ICT equipment – Desktops, IPADS
- Providing opportunities for teachers and teacher aides to develop skills and knowledge – communication / curriculum / engagement
- Providing pre-moderation sessions for teachers – English/Maths/Science
- Supporting teachers to utilise student data for termly case management target setting

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • 5 x Teacher Relief Scheme (TRS) days to support GR8 Start coordinator | \$2,000 |
| • TRS days to support Pre-moderation and case management sessions | \$20,000 |
| • Establishing Playgroup | \$2,000 |
| • Purchasing ICT Equipment | \$25,000 |
| • Purchasing equipment for 2 sensory spaces | \$6,648 |
| • Purchasing equipment to establish Makerspace area | \$10,000 |
| • Creating and distributing Communication calendar 2020 | \$2,000 |
| • Reviewing and editing Nambour Special School Pedagogy Wheel | \$1,500 |
| • Purchasing teacher aide time to attend Committee meetings | \$2,000 |
| • Providing disability specific pedagogy training – Train the trainer and staff PD | \$10,000 |
| • Purchasing TRS to support communication (ROCC) implementation | \$3,000 |
